



Julie Cab Card Customer Agreement

The Julie Cab Card (JC card) is a taxi credit card for youths to use to get home safely. The credit card account is applied for by parents and/or guardians, and it is for the use of their children. The parents or guardians are financially responsible for the account. The program has been created as another tool for parents to use in their efforts to keep their children safe.

The card is honoured by all major cab companies in the CRD, regardless of who has issued the card. The hope is that it will soon be honoured by all companies in the CRD.

In applying for the Julie Cab Card, the parent or guardian understands the following guidelines:

- a) The user must identify that they are a Julie Cab Card customer when they place the call to the cab company (see below)
- b) The user must inform the cab driver that they are a Julie Cab Card customer when they get in the cab
- c) The user should produce ID (student ID or Zip card is fine) when using their Julie Cab Card
- d) They applicant must agree to pay ALL charges incurred on the Julie Cab Card
- e) There is a single trip limit of \$75 on all Julie Cab Card transactions – unless pre-authorized by the card's guarantor, (the parent or guardian - not the card's user)
- f) The Julie Cab Card is the property of the issuing company may be revoked at anytime
- g) The applicant must keep the account up to date - any account that is more than 60 days in arrears may have its credit privileges revoked.

A little background...

As a general rule, street corner calls and cell phone calls are low-priority calls for cab companies as they are often non-viable calls. The cost of these non-viable calls is a loss in earnings for our drivers. The Julie Cab Card customer is asked to identify that this is a Julie Cab Card transaction **WHEN CALLING IN FOR THE CAB**. This is the only way that we can ensure that a car will be sent in a timely fashion to all locations for the teen.
